

Don't let **flu** happen to your patients



Each year, approximately **5-20%** of U.S. residents get the **flu** and more than **200,000 people** are hospitalized for flu-related complications.¹

Your patients are *vulnerable*. They are counting on you.

Remember:

- Remind your patients to get vaccinated against the flu.
- Dispel myths preventing flu vaccination.
- One question on the CAHPS® Survey (administered to Medicare enrollees each Spring) is whether or not the enrollee received the flu vaccine.

Getting the **flu vaccine** is the best protection against the **flu**.

Flu vaccines codes:

- Flu vaccine (trivalent)- Combo vaccine with two strains of influenza
 - CPT codes 90655-90658 (depending on age and if preservative free or not)
 - CPT Q2035 (Afluria) **Medicare only**
 - CPT Q2036 (Flulaval) **Medicare only**
 - CPT Q2037 (Fluvrin) **Medicare only**
- Flu vaccine/FluMist (quadrivalent) – Combo vaccine with 3 strains of influenza
 - CPT 90672 – intranasal, ages 2-18
 - CPT 90685 – intramuscular, ages 6-35 months
 - CPT 90686 – intramuscular, ages 3 and older
- Fluzone high dose (ages 65 and older)
 - CPT 9066
